

## Updated School Resumption Policies from Jiangsu Provincial Education Office

Dear International Students,

Sincere greetings from NAU! We'd like to have your attention on the latest progress of the school resumption policies within Jiangsu Provincial Level. On March. 21st, Jiangsu Provincial Education Office formally released the latest guiding plan for all levels of schools. The following are the major contents of the announcement:

1. On Mar. 30th, Junior 3 and Senior 3 grades of Middle Schools in Jiangsu Province will be the 1st batch to be resumed;
2. Other Middle School grades, all grades of elementary schools, kindergartens, vocational schools can be prepared to resume since April 7<sup>th</sup>;
3. Universities can be prepared to resume since April 13<sup>th</sup>, and each university is to propose the exact date according to its actual situation under the authorization of Jiangsu Provincial Education Office.

Based on the official guidance of Jiangsu Provincial Education Office, NAU will work out its own resumption plan. We'd like to require international students to continue waiting for our further notification released in this forum. You are expected to closely follow your academic school's requirements of online courses or thesis writing. And most important of all, international students who are now outside of China SHOULD NOT come back to campus without communicating and obtaining NAU's permission. Any violation of the regulations will cause severe warning and punishments. Please refer to Item 5 of the last document that we officially released on Mar.18<sup>th</sup>,2020.

**5. Consequences.** Any international student returning to NAU without prior application or intentionally hiding the truth of her/his route via highly infected countries/regions will result in:

- 1) penalty of NAU, as severe as expelling from NAU, according to the consequences her/his return causes;
- 2) charges by local government and NAU, according to laws and regulations promulgated to prevent contagion diseases;
- 3) NAU reserves the right to deny any student's entry to NAU without official approval granted by the afore-mentioned authorities.

We will keep you updated with the ongoing process to ensure you have enough time for making personal plans in advance.
