

## Official Notification of NAU School Resumption Policies, Apr. 2020

Dear International Students,

SIE is now extending its sincere gratitude to all our international students, both on campus and outside China for their unselfish support for the past three months in our combat against COVID-19. Now SIE, once again, on behalf of Nanjing Audit University, calls for your attention and cooperation.

On Apr.15<sup>th</sup>, 2020, NAU COVID-19 Prevention and Control Committee has officially released the school resumption policies concerning all NAU students. Following are the main contents of this notice:

1. Chinese students inside of China can apply to return to campus or apply NOT to return based on their own individual situations. NAU will be open for those who have been approved to come back since Apr.23. Apr. 23-26 will be their official registration dates.
2. International students and Chinese students outside China, students from medium-/high- affected domestic regions SHALL NOT return to campus till further guidance is provided.
3. Starting from Apr. 27<sup>th</sup> till the end of this semester, classes will continue to be delivered mainly through on-line teaching. Final semester examinations, where applicable, are to be carried out in online form as well.
4. After students' return, the whole campus is going to be on a lock-down management mode from Apr. 23<sup>rd</sup> to ensure safety. NAU will get all students informed about the time to re-open the campus after taking into consideration the most updated domestic and international situation of COVID-19. No students are allowed to leave the campus during this period without the approval from management's permission. Lockdown policies will be further evaluated and adjusted based on the actual situation.

Based on the above NAU official policies regarding school resumption, SIE is giving out the following requirements and tips respectively for international students outside of China and on campus.

### **For international students currently outside of China:**

1. Follow NAU policies NOT to return to China until further guidance is officially released.
2. Focus on your thesis writing and regular online-courses learning respectively for 2018 Batch and 2019 Batch. Keep frequent and effective contact with your

supervisors and class coordinators of your current situation.

3. Fill out the monthly allowance application form as required for receiving your allowance on time. The March and April allowance will be distributed to your accounts before the end of Apr by the Financial Department. And you are required to submit the application form of May before May. 10<sup>th</sup> under the condition that you fulfil all the academic requirements.

**For international students on campus:**

1. Apr. 23<sup>rd</sup> to 26<sup>th</sup> will be the registration dates for Chinese students inside of China to come back to campus. From 23<sup>rd</sup> on, the campus will be locked down. International students on campus are also required to stay on campus during that period. NAU will keep you informed of the date when the campus will be open again after taking into consideration of the most updated domestic and international situation of COVID-19 and for your safety reasons.
2. During the campus lockdown, logistic department will resume the assistance for international students for food purchase, twice a week.
3. Please wear masks wherever and whenever you go outside your dormitory to keep safe and ensure a safe distance from others.
4. Once school is resumed, canteens and supermarkets will be fully open. So the daily supplies will be abundant. However, we still strongly suggest you avoid frequenting the public indoor areas on campus to reduce unnecessary social contacts, **esp. during the first 14 days**. If you go to canteens, we suggest you pack your food away with your own utensils.
5. Please be noted that the alarming body temperature of NAU security check is 37.3 degrees Celsius. Make sure to check your daily temperature and report on your block chain accurately. Be responsible for both you yourselves and others around. If anyone is feeling sick or having high fever, make sure to first quarantine yourself and then contact your class coordinator in time.
6. Recently there will be some regular dormitory security check conducted by both NAU Security Department and SIE, please always be reminded to pay attention to the safe and proper use of all electrical appliances. Free electricity policy will end since Apr.23<sup>rd</sup>.
7. To assist students to better cope with this tensing situation, NAU psychological clinic is offering hot line services for mental consultation if anyone is feeling stressed or worried. Tel: 025-58318627, 58255200.
